

Isolation / Exposure / Quarantine Decision Tree

Aligned with California State and San Mateo County Public Health Directives

COVID-19 Symptomatic (vaccinated & unvaccinated)

Isolate and Test

COVID-19 Positive (vaccinated or unvaccinated)

Isolation 10 days from positive test or when symptoms began (whichever came first)

Exposure to Confirmed COVID-19 Positive Individual

Was the exposure time indoors, closer than 6ft, and greater than 15 minutes cumulatively?**

(regardless of face covering wearing)

Negative

May return to campus if no fever for 24 hrs and symptoms improved.

Positive

Isolation 10 days from symptoms presentation

Notification

Only individuals who are directed to isolate, quarantine, or identified as a close contact exposure will be notified.

No

No restrictions applied

Yes

Is the individual fully vaccinated?

Reporting Procedure

If you have tested positive, are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms (stay home and do not come to campus), OR think you may have been exposed to someone who tested positive:

Yes Fully Vaccinated

Exempt from quarantine.

- Symptom monitor for 14 days
- COVID-19 testing recommended (but not required) 5-7 days following last exposure.

If tests positive, isolation for 10 days from positive results.

No—Unvaccinated

Quarantine for 10 days and continue to mask and monitor for symptoms for the full 14-days

COVID-19 testing recommended (but not required)
5-7 days following last
exposure.

If tests positive, isolation for 10 days from positive results.

Release From Isolation / Quarantine

Isolation and quarantine directed individuals will provide self-attestation to COVID-19 Health Officer (CHO). The following must be assessed:

- Acknowledgement of directive for isolation (COVID+ test) or quarantine (symptomatic or confirmed exposure)
- Completion of isolation or quarantine (beginning and ending date) consistent with CDC recommendations
- Confirmation of no symptoms; or improved symptoms, and no fever for 24 hours without fever reducing medication

A follow up negative COVID test is NOT required for release

** Close Contact Exposure

Being within six feet of a COVID-19 case for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or greater in any 24-hour period within or overlapping with the "highrisk exposure period" regardless of the use of face coverings.

++ Fully Vaccinated

2 weeks (14 days) post completing your COVID-19 vaccination series (2 doses for Pfizer and Moderna OR single dose Johnson & Johnson Janssen)
