Candidacy

To be considered an eligible candidate you must complete the following:

- Complete and turn in ASCC Appointment Packet. Please attach a copy of your unofficial transcript. Student must complete 50% or more of all units with grades of A, B, C, D or P each semester.** Student must maintain a 2.00 GPA or higher and be currently enrolled in 5 units for Senator and/or 6 or more units for Executive Position at Cañada College.
- Read and sign a copy of the ASCC Constitution and Bylaws** which can be found in the Center for Student Life and Leadership Development 5-354. Ask for the ASCC 2012-2013 Binder.
- Attend 3 ASCC General Board meetings and collect 25 signatures from Cañada students.** At the end of your 3rd meeting you will be interviewed and voted on your appointment to the board. Spring **ASCC Meetings are Tuesdays, 3:15-5pm, Building 2 rm 10. First mtg. is Jan. 22nd.**

4 Senator Positions. Senators shall:

1. Attend all ASCC meetings. Spring ASCC Meetings are Tuesdays, 3:15-5pm in Building 2-10.
2. Support ASCC events and functions.
3. Serve on a college district or campus committee and represent Clubs.
4. Work on a project or task set by the Executive Board.
5. Be enrolled in at least 5 units and have a cumulative GPA of 2.0

Eligibility Verification

In accordance with **Education Code 76061** eligibility requirements are set forth as follows: Associated Students of Cañada College senators shall continuously meet the requirements specified in Education Code 76061 [A student who is elected to serve as an officer in the student government of a community college shall meet both of the following requirements: (a) The student shall be enrolled in the community college at the time of election, and throughout his or her term, with a minimum of five semester units, or its equivalent. (b) The student shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of scholarship prescribed for community college students by the community college district]. Eligibility shall be verified twice in the fall and twice in the spring. Verification shall be provided by the Coordinator of Student Activities or designee.

All students applying to the Associated Students of Cañada College must be in “good standing” as defined in the current Cañada College Catalog. A student in good academic standing status has earned a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0, a “C” average or better.

All students serving on the ASCC Executive Board must maintain (be continuously enrolled in) at **least six (6) registered units, senators five (5) units** at Cañada College each semester during their term of office and maintain a cumulative **GPA of 2.0 or higher**.
