We acknowledge that Cañada College is situated on the traditional unceded land of the Ramaytush (Rahmy-toosh) Ohlone (Oh-LOW-nee) peoples, and we respect our past elders and honor the present community. Long before Cañada College existed, this area was home to the Ramaytush Ohlone peoples, who still have a presence in the Bay Area today.

We have a responsibility to acknowledge that we as a Cañada community have benefited from the use and occupation of this land and that the tragic legacy of colonization, genocide, capitalism, racism, and oppression still impacts people today.

We also recognize the labor upon which this educational institution, state, and country is built.

We acknowledge the peoples of African ancestry who were enslaved and forcibly brought to this land, and whose forced labor played a major role in the formation of this country. We are indebted to their uncompensated labor and their unwilling sacrifice over hundreds of years—which continues to impact generations today. We acknowledge the contributions of all immigrant labor, forced labor, and undocumented people who contributed, and continue to contribute, to the building and feeding of this land. We acknowledge their immeasurable sacrifices and work that allow us to gather in this space today.

Let us honor and engage with the people who have stewarded and labored on this land for generations, and let us honor these truths—by taking responsibility as a college community to continually educate ourselves about these realities, to affirm our commitment to justice through continual action, and to protect and sustain this land.

<i>Alexis recalls that he doesn't think we will be able to pull from activites and we would have to reallocate funds from another account. Shanda says that we are not in the red, requisition forms have not been returned yet. Alexis asks if annual budget is 154,000. SHanda answers it was originall 122,000 but we added funds so yes. Shanda is unsure how students will get funds for next semester since we originally got it from body funds and such.. Shanda will check with Mario on Monday and Sergio to confirm exactly what our total allocated budget was and make sure to see who has not submitted a requisition form and email them so we can have an accurate question. Zi questions what next year funds have to do with this years funds. Shanda explains it has nothing to do with this semseter. Alexis says the budget form 25-26, the total is 154,000 and so far they aree 110,156 and we have 44,000 left with a chunk from events. Shanda explains that people don't turn in requisition forms immediately and the limit is June 1st. Shanda explains that if she was revoted, she would add a limit of 2 weeks or else they are unable to get compensated. Alecis states that if we have 44,000 ASCC accounts have about 25,000. Vijeet clarifies what timeline the funds are for. Shanda answers until June 30th. Ziara states we will need more funding in the club account since there are more requests since the account will go into red. Shanda says to let us know how much she needs.
