The requests below are only for computers that have been in use since the building opened in June, 2007. The Learning Center is open M – Th 8 – 9pm, and on Friday 8 – 3pm. each semester, and is in constant use by classes, students, tutors, and faculty. During the breaks, all computers are in use for Math Jams and Word Jams. Although, at times, students are using the computers for their personal use, they are heavily used by students doing academic use. Technology use to support instruction is growing each semester. For this reason, it would be detrimental to lessen the number of computers available.

- Front Lab (Room 221)
 - 38 Thick
 - 1 iMac
 - Because this area can be cordoned off, this lab is used by students in general, and as a classroom, on request, throughout the semester. When being used as a class, students must shift to the other areas in the Center.
- Tutorial Center
 - 6 Thick
 - Used by tutors/tutees working with online programs such as Aplia, and for essay development.
- Main Lab (Room 205)
 - 26 Thick
 - Used by students through the semester, at all hours of operation.
 - 6 Z220
 - For specialty programs such as AutoCAD and Pronunciation Power
- STEM
 - 2 Z220
 - Replace 2 very old computers. Used by all math/CIS students/tutors at all hours of operation.
- 9-257A
 - 11 Thick
 - Has become the overflow for the STEM Center. More demand during the semester and during Math Jams.
 - 1 Z220
 - Instructor computer. This space is used for presentations and workshops for the Campus.
- Staff / Student Assistants
 - 9 Z220


