How to Apply	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must apply online at www2.calstate.edu/apply • You complete one application and choose campus and major for each campus. Your application will be sent separately to each campus. • You need to report all, courses completed, in progress, planned and planned for each campus you attended. • It is important to provide an accurate EMAIL ADDRESS. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply online to UC campuses at Website: http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/index.html or apply.universityofcalifornia.edu. • Only one application is necessary to apply to multiple UC campuses!! • The UC campuses will communicate via email; therefore, it is important to have an EMAIL ADDRESS and check it on a regular basis once you submit the application. • In your application, you must provide a list of <u>all</u> courses, your accomplishments, and respond to 4 Personal Insight Questions- each maximum of 350 words.
When to Apply	<p>Winter Quarter 2021: <u>June 1 – 30, 2020</u></p> <p>Spring Semester or Quarter 2021: <u>August 1 – 30, 2020</u></p> <p>Fall Semester or Quarter 2021: <u>October 1 – November 30, 2020</u></p> <div style="background-color: #fff9c4; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Note: You may check calstate.edu/apply for winter and spring open/closed campuses.</p> </div>	<p>UC campuses are on quarter system except UC Berkeley and UC Merced.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Fall 2021: <u>November 1 – 30, 2020</u> <u>UC Application will be available on August 1, 2020</u></p> <p>UC Merced, UC Riverside, UC Santa Cruz accept application for Spring/Winter 2021 for selected majors. All other UC campuses are closed for Spring/Winter 2021. The application deadline for Spring and Winter is July 1-31st.</p>
Application Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The application fee is \$70 per application. You must include the payment of fees when you submit your application online; otherwise it will not be processed. (You may pay by PayPal, or Credit Card or Debit Card.) <div style="background-color: #fff9c4; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Fee Waivers: The application fees may be waived up to 4 campuses for CSU and 4 campuses for UC for those students who meet the criteria. Students must complete the CSU/UC application to find whether they are qualified.</p> </div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The application fee for resident students is \$70 and for non-resident students \$80 per campus. If you apply to more than one campus, you must pay an additional \$70/\$80 for each campus you select. You must include the payment of fees with your application; otherwise it will not be processed. (You may pay by Check, Money Order, or Credit Card.)
Acknowledgement	<p>You will receive acknowledgment from the campus to which you applied. Read this notification carefully and follow the instructions on how to check your application status online. Each campus will provide you with a username and password to access your portal page to check your application status and any action you need to take under the “To Do List”.</p>	<p>Once you submit your application, you’ll receive an e-mail confirming it has been successfully filed. Four to five weeks later, you should get another acknowledgment from the UC Undergraduate Application Processing Service confirming your application and fees were received. If you do not receive this acknowledgment, contact the processing service at ucinfo@applyucsupport.net, or call (800) 207-1710 within the U.S.</p>
Application Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must update your application with the final grades using Cal State Apply. Some of the CSU campuses require a supplemental application and some may ask for an official transcript to reflect your final grades. • You must accept the Admission offer, and confirm it by completing Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) by May 1st for fall term. This deadline varies for spring admissions. • When you are admitted to a campus, you should check your portal page to learn about “To Do List”, the orientation dates, registration, and other actions you need to take as a new student. • If it is required, arrange to take the English/writing Test as soon as possible. • The deadlines for submitting <u>final transcripts with spring grades, test scores, and any other documentation is July 15th for fall admission</u>. This deadline varies for Spring term. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will be required to submit an APPLICATION UPDATE form online (www.universityofcalifornia.edu/admissions/appupdate) which will include the submission of your fall grades and confirm your coursework for the spring term, and to provide the UC campuses with your most current academic information. Place close attention to the deadlines for submitting the updates as each campus may have different deadline. • They will notify you of their decision between Mid-March and the end of April • You must confirm the acceptance of their offer by completing Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) by June 1st. • The deadlines for submitting <u>final transcripts with spring grades, test scores, and any other documentation is July 1st</u>. <div style="background-color: #fff9c4; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Not updating your application and/or responding to their requests will cause your admission to be rescinded by CSU and UC.</p> </div>

Note: You may request a certification of completion of CSU General Education Breadth or IGETC, if applicable, to be sent to the University of your Choice along with your official transcript. To do so, you may request an official transcript via WEBSMART, and as part of your request, check the box for CSU GE or IGETC certification. You MUST submit your final transcript and the certification by the deadline prior to your enrollment.
