What is Financial Aid?

Funds provided to students to help pay for postsecondary education expenses.

Financial aid includes:

- Grants
- Scholarships
- Work study
- Loans



Calculating Need Based Eligibility

$$\begin{array}{l} \text{Cost of Attendance (COA)} \\ - \text{Expected Family Contribution (EFC)} \\ \hline = \text{Eligibility for Need-Based Aid} \end{array}$$

Cost of Attendance (COA)

Standard Costs	Optional Costs
Tuition and fees	Student loan fees
Room and board	Study-abroad
Books and Supplies	Disability-related services
Transportation	Employment expenses for co-op study
Miscellaneous personal expenses	Child or dependent care

Note: Costs vary from institution to institution

Expected Family Contribution (EFC)

- EFC is the measure of a family's financial strength
- EFC is used to determine the **student and parent ability to contribute towards the student's cost of education**
- Need analysis is the consistent formula used in determining a family's EFC



Cost of Attendance

SJSU: (On Campus)

- \$ 7,852 Tuition
- \$ 16,946 Room and Board
- \$ 2,058 Books and Supplies
- \$ 1,704 Personal Expenses
- \$ 1,505 Transportation

Total: \$30,065

UC Berkeley: (On Campus Apt)

- \$14,254 Tuition and Fees
- \$14,274 Room and Board
- \$ 3,568 Food
- \$ 1,094 Books and Supplies
- \$ 1,792 Personal Expenses
- \$ 594 Transportation

Total: \$35,576

Menlo College (At Home)

- \$45,010 Tuition
- \$ 6,750 Room and Board
- \$ 1,080 Books and Supplies
- \$ 3,225 Personal Expenses
- \$ 934 Transportation
- \$ 810 Fees

Total: \$57,809

Need-Based Aid

Program	Award Amount	Notes
Pell Grant	Up to \$6,345	Lifetime Eligibility 600% (max)
FSEOG (grant)	\$100 to \$4,000	Priority to Pell eligible students
TEACH Grant	Up to \$4,000	Requires service contract otherwise converts to unsubsidized loan
Work Study	Varies by school	On and off-campus employment
Subsidized Direct Loan	\$4,500- \$5,500 (Jr and Sr grade level)	Interest subsidy during periods of enrollment of at least ½ time. Currently 4.53% int rate.

Cal Grant A and B (tuition/fees)	Up to \$12,630 (Public); \$9084 (Independents); \$4,000 (For Profit)
Cal Grant B Access Award	\$1,672 (Plus tuition/fees)
Chafee Grant (Former Foster Youth)	Up to \$5000
UC Student Aid	\$100 or more
California State University Grant (SUG)	Covers full system-wide fees

UC Blue & Gold Opportunity Plan

- Complete the FAFSA or CA Dream App by March 2
- Total family income below \$80,000 and demonstrate financial need
- Be enrolled at least ½ time, meet academic progress standards
- **Covers systemwide tuition & fees**

Middle Class Scholarship

Who is Eligible?

Only students who have less than 40% of their UC or CSU fees covered by grants and scholarships

- ✓ Income \$177,000 or Less
- ✓ Asset \$177,000 or Less
- ✓ U.S. Citizen, eligible Non-Citizen or AB 540
- ✓ Must be enrolled at least ½ time
- ✓ Meets Selective Service requirement
- ✓ Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress standards

UC Max award - \$5,052

CSU Max award - \$2,298

California DREAM Loan Program

- Maximum award per year is **\$4,000**, but each UC & CSU campus will determine the amount
- Can borrow each year – maximum aggregate is \$20,000
- Must be at least ½ time
- Interest same as Federal Student Loans
 - 4.53% current rate
 - 6 month grace period before repayment begins

Non-Need Based Aid

- **Unsubsidized Direct Loan**

- **Interest accrues** while student is enrolled- can be paid while in school or added at repayment
- Interest is fixed- currently 4.53% (7/1/2019-6/30/2020)
- Principal payment deferred until 6 months after graduating

- **Private Loans**

- Credit based, interest can be fixed or variable
- Usually requires a co-signer

- **Parent PLUS Loan**

- Subject to credit check- no adverse credit history
- Loan limits: COA less other aid
- Interest is fixed- currently 7.08%; fees up to 4%
- Repayment may begin while the student is in school or can be deferred until after graduation.
