Types of Associate Degree

- ✓ **Associate Degree**

- In Arts (AA)
 - In Sciences

- ✓ **Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)**

- In Arts (AAT)
 - In Sciences (AST)

Certificate

Course requirements in a field of study only




Major
Course
requirements

- Unit requirements for each Certificate is different
- Some programs may have several Certificates such as Interior Design
- 50% of major requirements must be completed at Cañada

Associate Degree

Associate Degree = major courses + General Education + electives (Graduation requirements)




- Unit requirements for each major is different
- Local General Education and graduation requirements are the same for all
- 50% of major requirements must be completed at Cañada
- Complete at least 12 units at Cañada College.

Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) AA-T/AS-T Degree

60 transfer units

AI, Electives

- Unit requirements for each major is different
- General Education: CSU GE Breadth or IGETC
- Complete at least 12 units at Cañada College

ADT Degree vs. Local Degree

AA-T/AS-T Degrees:

Requires 60 CSU transferrable units that includes:

- CSU GE or IGETC for CSU
- Major courses
- Electives if needed

Local AA/AS degrees:

- 60 degree applicable (majority of the courses will also transfer to CSU)
- Students must complete all the local Associate degree requirements based on the catalog rights

Case Scenario

Sally Completed 60 degree applicable units that includes Cañada College GE requirements, Ethnic Studies and Math 120.

Is she ready to transfer?

Is she eligible for an ADT?

Answer to the Case Scenario

The answer is no because she did not complete 60 Transferrable units. And it is not clear whether she completed the major requirements.

ADT does not require the local graduation requirements such as Ethnic Studies and P.E., but it requires at least 12 units to be completed at Cañada College.

What are the benefits. . .

- Priority admission to CSU campuses, private and Out of state universities
- Guarantee admission to a CSU campus
- ADT students admitted to CSU in a “similar” major will complete the BA/BS in 60 semester units
- GPA Bump for CSU campuses

Will receive an Associate Degree at the same time of completing CSU GE certification, and transfer requirements


What are the benefits? Continued ...

- Spring Admission to CSU campuses (selected campuses – see <https://www2.calstate.edu/apply>)
- Redirect to an alternate CUS Campus if not accepted to any campus of you applied
- Will facilitate the transfer process to a CSU campus that there is no major course articulated

Additional Notes

- Additional Course works that may be used as electives at CSU Campuses
- must be complete lower division courses in major that are not completed at a community college after transferring to CSU
- Spend more time at community College
- Complex transfer planning

From Community College to CSU, Private, and Out of State Universities with ADT Degree

- Meet with your counselor to discuss the option
- plan ahead, complete an SEP
- Complete a petition for an Associate Degree for transfer (ADT) with your counselor
- Bring your petition to the Transfer Center to receive a verification of completion of the ADT degree

From Community College to CSU..... Continued

- When applying to CSU campuses, during the application period, declare the intent of obtaining an ADT degree
- On the CSU application, must select a similar degree as your ADT to receive the benefit of priority admission
- Make sure to follow the deadlines of submitting the required documents to CSU including the verification letter from Transfer Center
