MEET THE ADMISSION CONDITIONS

Exception Under The Current Situation (winter, spring, summer 2020 Enrollment")

UC – Pass/No Pass, Summer Completion

CSU – Pass/no Pass (all), transfer with 48 semester units

SUBMIT THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS BY THE DEADLINE (Transcripts, GE Certification, Residency Documents, Health Insurance Immunization, etc.)

IF REQUIRES, TAKE ENTRY LEVEL WRITING EXAMS

California Non-Residential Tuition Exemption Request

To be submitted by an AB 540/Dreamers student after the student has accepted their admission via Statement of Intent to Register (SIR);

- The affidavit is required by the UC campus the student will be attending
- The affidavit states that the student will adjust their status, as soon as they are eligible to do so
- Students are not required to submit a new affidavit when there is continuous enrollment
- The information on the affidavit is kept confidential, as required by law. Immigration has no access to student information
