

California Non-Residential Tuition Exemption Request

To be submitted by an AB 540/Dreamers student after the student has accepted their admission via Statement of Intent to Register (SIR);

- The affidavit is required by the UC campus the student will be attending
- The affidavit states that the student will adjust their status, as soon as they are eligible to do so
- Students are not required to submit a new affidavit when there is continuous enrollment
- The information on the affidavit is kept confidential, as required by law. Immigration has no access to student information

Complete and sign this form to request exemption from Nonresident Tuition and the Educational Fee differential charged to nonresident students. Once you are determined to be eligible for the exemption, you will continue to receive the exemption as long as you fulfill the requirements listed below or the University no longer offers this exemption, whichever occurs first.

Applying for the exemption does not in any way alter your responsibility to pay on time any nonresident tuition and associated fees that may be due before your eligibility is determined.

APPLICATION
I, the undersigned, am applying for a University of California Nonresident Tuition Exemption for Eligible California High School Graduates and declare that ALL of the following apply to me (check YES or NO boxes):

YES NO 1. I have attended high school in California for three or more years; and

YES NO 2. I have graduated from a California high school or have attained the equivalent thereof, such as a High School Equivalency Certificate, issued by the California State GED Office or a Certificate of Proficiency, resulting from the California High School Proficiency Examination; and

YES NO 3. I am NOT a non-immigrant alien. [Non-immigrants, as defined by federal law, have been admitted to the United States temporarily and may have been granted one of the following visas: A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, TN, TD, V, TROV, and NATO].

I understand that this information will be used to determine my eligibility for the tuition exemption. I further understand that if any of the above information is found to be false, I will be liable for payment of all nonresident charges from which I was exempted and may be subject to disciplinary action by the University.

- Complete The Intent To Enroll/Statement of Intent To Register and pay the fee
 - [UC Campuses](#) - UC \$250
 - [CSU Campuses](#) - Varies

- Check The Deadlines To Accept The Offer
 - CSU: May 1st
 - UC: June 1st
 - Accept the Waitlist invitation by May 15th (the decision will be made between June 1st and July 31st)
 - To accept the Waitlist offer varies between UC Campuses
 - Other Universities: Varies

Appeal To Admission Decision

- ❑ UC - Deadline May 15th except:
 - ❑ Santa Barbara (June 15)
 - ❑ Santa Cruz (14 days from the date the denial was posted on my.ucsc.edu)
- ❑ Appeal to UC if there is a new evidence
- ❑ Appeal to waitlist – only UC Merced and UC Santa Cruz allow it
- ❑ CSU – Varies by campus – usually in 2 weeks from receiving the denial letter.

To Appeal may need:

- Statement explaining the circumstances
- Evidence/documents
- Forms (if applicable)



After Accepting An Offer!

- Meet the admission conditions
 - Exception under the current situation (winter, spring, summer 2020 Enrollment”
 - UC – Pass/No Pass, Summer Completion
 - CSU – Pass/no Pass (all), transfer with 48 semester units
- Submit the required documents by the deadline (transcripts, GE certification, residency documents, health insurance immunization, etc.)
- If requires, take entry level writing exams
- Register for the orientation
 - UC: [check for the orientation dates](#)
 - CSU: [Date And Fees Varies By Each Campus](#) (i.e. SJSU is \$80, SFSU is waiving it this year due to COVID)
- Consult with financial aid office
- Search and apply for the scholarships offered by the university
- File housing application if needed



Deadlines

Transcript Submission Deadlines

- UC campuses: July 1, 2021
- CSU campuses: July 15, 2021

- Official verification of ADT for CSU Campuses:
March 15th and July 15th , 2021

- Private and out of state university: varies

NOTE: IGETC and CSU GE Breadth must be also submitted before enrollment at CSU OR UC

Prepare for The Transition

- Find resources on campus
- Transfer-specific support programs
- Attend the orientation
 - Meet with an advisor to review the transferred-in courses
- Get acquainted with the campus
- If possible, meet with faculty and staff of the department
- Register for classes
- Pay for your classes/ housing etc.
- Buy your books
- Health insurance
- Transportation
- Locate your classrooms
- Attend classes
