TRIO Student Support Services is a federally funded program designed to serve college students with a demonstrated academic need. Eligible students are low-income and/or first generation students (neither parent has a U.S. college Bachelor's degree), and/or have a documented learning or physical disability. **All services are provided at no cost to qualifying students.**

**Requirements:**

- Meet eligibility requirements
- Registered in at least 6 units
- Exception for students with reduced unit accommodation
- Majority of units taken at Cañada College if attending multiple SMCCCD campuses
- Have not previously earned a Bachelor's degree

**Please Note:** Due to our funding source (United States Department of Education), services are available to eligible students who are U.S. Citizens or Permanent Residents.

## Cañada College TRIO-SSS Agreement

### REQUIREMENTS OF ALL STUDENTS

Welcome to the TRIO-SSS program! The following guidelines are designed to ensure your academic success. As a participant, you are agreeing to: **(please initial each item)**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Take at least 6 academic units (a majority of which are taken at Cañada).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Attend all enrolled classes and complete all assigned homework and tests on time.\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Notify your instructors of any absences and make up any missed assignments as soon as possible.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit progress reports for each academic class by the assigned date.
- \_\_\_\_\_ See a TRIO-SSS program counselor at least **TWO times per semester**.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meet with the TRIO-SSS counselor before adding/dropping any classes or changing your class schedule.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Participate in at least **TWO TRIO activities per semester**.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Attend all scheduled tutoring sessions on time and well-prepared.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel any scheduled appointments (email: cantrio@smccd.edu)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Notify TRIO-SSS staff of changes in contact information.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Maintain a "my.smccd.edu" email address and to **check it weekly**.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Hold harmless the SMCCD District and the Canada College TRIO-SSS Program against any damages as a result of attending a TRIO event.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Allow designated staff to have access to my financial aid information for program reporting purposes only, and I understand that all information obtained will be kept confidential (if applicable).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Be permanently dismissed from TRIO-SSS if you violate Cañada's academic integrity policy.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Personally and routinely check with each university/college into which you want to transfer, as their requirements and transfer agreements frequently change. The responsibility to successfully transfer ultimately is yours.**

### **Additional Requirements for Students on Academic Probation**

*Complete in case of Academic Probation*

- \_\_\_\_\_ Meet with a TRIO counselor at least *three* times during each semester.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit monthly progress reports
- \_\_\_\_\_ Attend a minimum of one tutoring session per week that will be specially designed to bring up my GPA.

**\*Students with DRC accommodations: within allowable time per accommodation letter.**

**Program dismissal – if the program requirements are not met, you will be dismissed from the program. You will have to appeal for reinstatement.**

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*Failure to follow participation guidelines or failure to maintain good academic standing can be grounds for probation or dismissal from the program.*
